

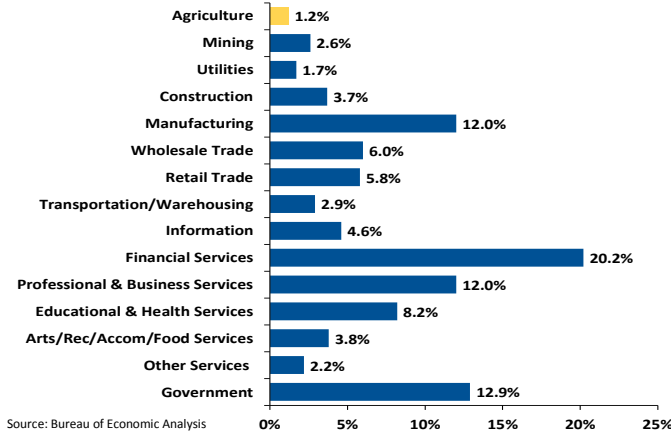

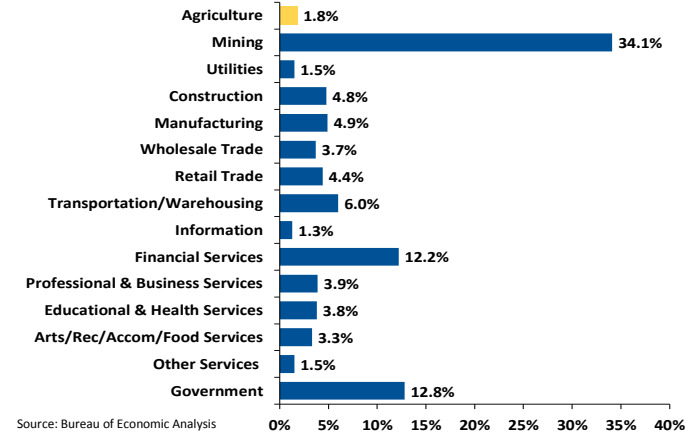
Gross Domestic Product: U.S. vs WY

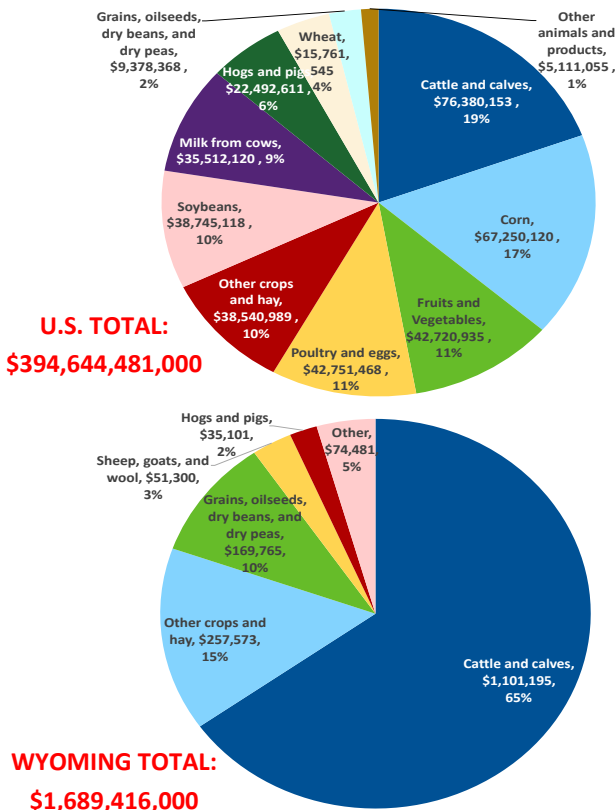

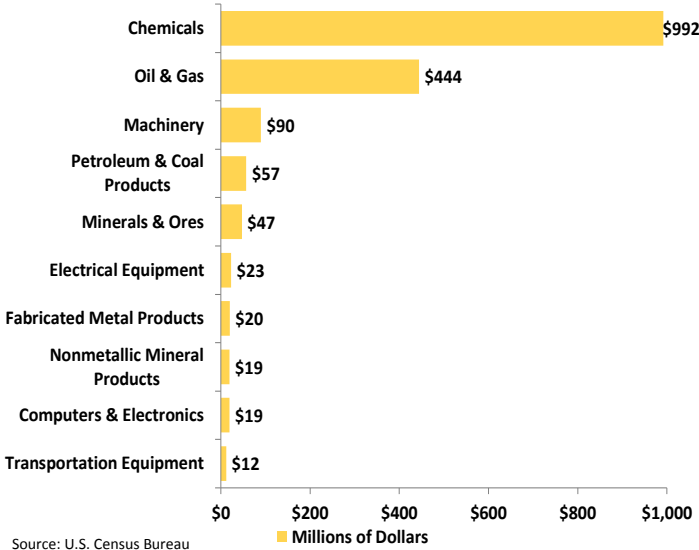

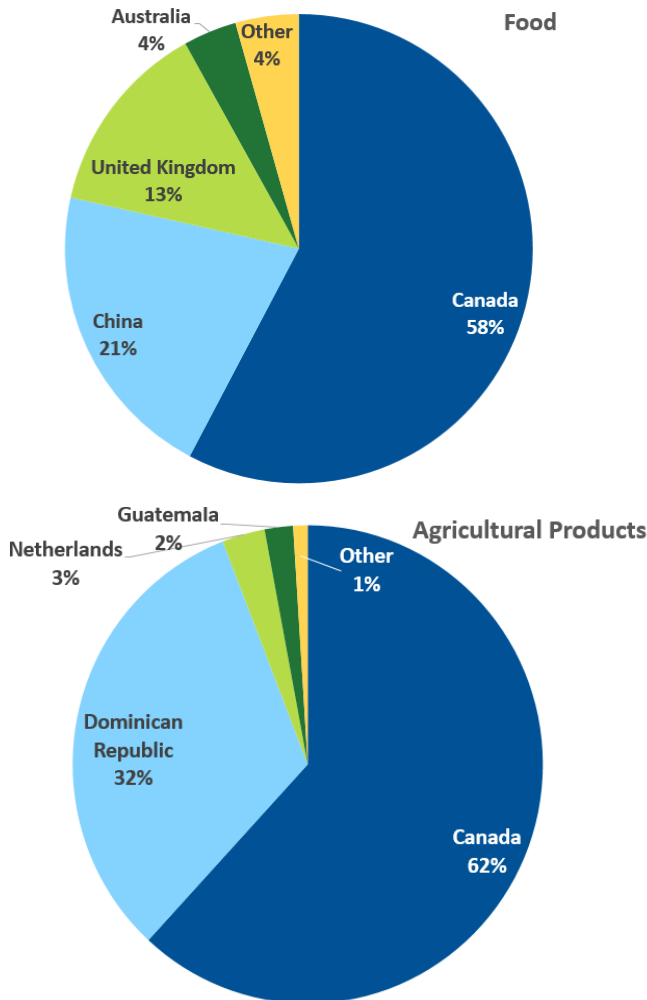

Purchasing Countries by Export Industry



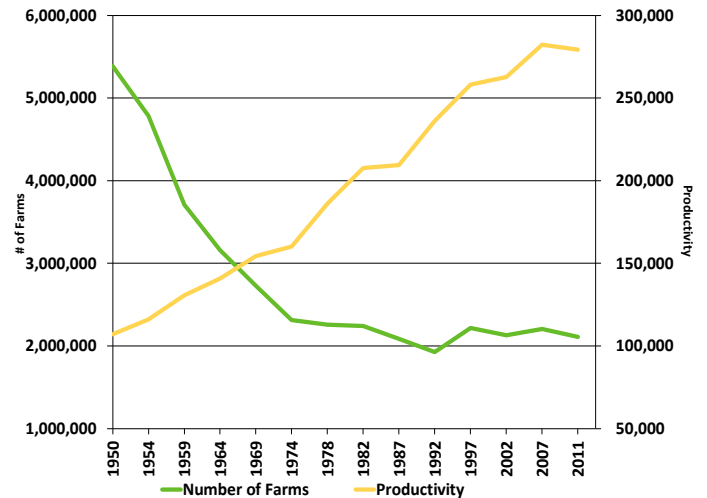
